

Safer door to door

What you should do





- Stay home if you're not feeling well, have had contact with a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case, or recently travelled outside Canada.
- Bring a mask or alternative with you on your trip.
 - All customers and employees are required to wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth while taking transit and inside both shelters and stations.



 Use hand sanitizer when you enter the bus or station and when you transfer. Hand sanitizer dispensers are located at every Line 1 station and most Transitway stations.



2 On a bus

- Board at the front of the bus and exit at the back of the bus. If you are riding in the Cooperative Seating area, you may continue to exit by the front doors.
 - You can also board at the back on articulated and double-decker buses, and any bus inside a fare-paid zone.
- Pay your fare at the front of the bus. Drop cash into the fare box or tap your Presto or other smart card to pay your fare touch-free.
- Speak with the Operator through a soft plastic shield protecting the Operator area if you have any guestions.

On the O-Train

- Board at any door. Bicycles may resume boarding at the first door of the train. Be sure to spread out and use all the space along the platform.
- Stand at the markings on the floor to help keep a safer distance from other riders.
- Wait for other riders to exit the train before you board the train.



Remember if you are sitting in a Cooperative seat but don't need to be, please offer your place to someone who needs it.



At your destination

- Use hand sanitizer before you exit the station.
- Wash your hands thoroughly when you reach your destination.
- Dispose of single-use face masks in a garbage bin. Please do not discard used masks or other PPE on the vehicle or on the ground.
